Classes: *Dormitory Cooking, Kayaking, Basic Automotive Skills, Get Golf Ready, Basic Surfing*

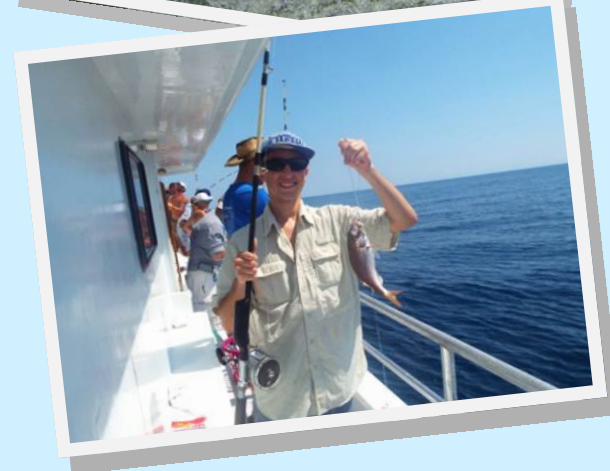
