

Hurlburt Field 2017

Greeting Card Contest

1. All greeting cards must have a holiday theme with no specific religious denomination. (If you need assistance on a religious theme, contact the Base Chapel at 884-7795.)
2. Get creative, but follow these design parameters:
 - Cards may be vertical or horizontal, but cannot exceed 8'x8'x8' (2 sheets of plywood). Add ons, cutouts and moving parts are permitted.
 - Cards requiring power must be supplied by a self-contained battery pack, small generator or have a 6', 110V cord with plug.
 - Card themes MUST be consistent with AFSOC cultural standard of military professionalism and promote a climate of respect and dignity.
 - Live plants or animals are not allowed.
 - Please weatherproof your card!
3. Designers or builders may consist of squadron/unit members or their families.
4. Previous contest entries may be displayed, but will not be entered into the contest.
5. Squadrons can pick up one (1) sheet of plywood at the Landing Zone Community Center (behind the Hurlburt Library) during open hours. Quantities are limited. One free sheet per squadron.
6. Please print POC and phone number on back of card and bring completed card to the display area (grassy roadside in front the Base Chapel) 8am-2pm on Tuesday, November 28; cards delivered after this date may not be judged.
7. All cards must be removed by Wednesday January 3, 2018 or they will be disposed of by 1 SOFSS.
