

Cardboard Boat Regatta

Rules & Regulations

- Boat and paddles must be constructed of plain cardboard. Water based paint, water soluble glue and traditional rolls of duct, masking or packaging tape are the only other materials permitted. Prohibited items include but are not limited to: cloth, wood, plastic, foam, metal materials and polyurethane (resin).
- Each boat must have a minimum of two crew members. Family members are eligible. Each participant must be at least 15 years old.
- Boats from previous years will not be eligible. Boats will be checked prior to award presentations.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will be reported to Mission Support Group Commander, and a \$100 fine will be enforced.
- A dumpster will be provided to dispose of boats. A \$100 fine will be charged for not disposing of your boat after the event.
- A shotgun start begins from shore. Each crew must put their boat into the water, paddle around a buoy and return to shore.
- Have fun!

Boats can be driven to the marina until 10am. After 10am, due to road closure, boats will have to be carried from the turn onto Corlew Road!
