Recharge for Resiliency: Deployed-Affected Program

Each month we host a special **FREE** event for deployed-affected families.

Eligibility: AF assigned service members returning from deployments or dependent-restricted assignments. Service member and families are eligible to participate upon receiving official deployment/remote tour orders, and up to one year after the member returns to home station.

Events are recreational, educational, historical, and/or cultural in nature. Typical events include: resin-art, Urban Air, axe-throwing, Painting With a Twist, animal experientials at the zoo and aquarium, DIY workshops, glass-bottom boat tours, and more! Childcare Options

Give Parents a Break (on hold due to COVID)

Free childcare offered once a month for families who register with the A&FRC. Typically, the 2nd Saturday of the month, from 9am-3pm.
(6wks-5yrs = CDC West; 6-12yrs = Youth Center)

Pre-Deployment, Deployment, & Return Home Care

The Expanded Child Care Program provides military families with 16 hours of pre-deployment, 16 hours each month during deployment, and 16 hours of post-deployment care, per child, in an Family Child Care (FCC) provider's home. Service member and supervisor must fill out an application and return to the FCC Coordinator. For more info, call the FCC office at 884-4300.

Respite Care

If you have a child with special needs, respite care may be available through the AF. NOTE: Referral basis only; please contact EFMP coordinator at 884-6830/8819.

Car Care Because We Care

An AF Aid grant provides up to \$32.50 for an oil change and 15-pt safety check for a family's primary vehicle during the member's absence. Certificates are available at the A&FRC... bring a copy of the service member's deployment orders.

Hug-a-Hero Doll
