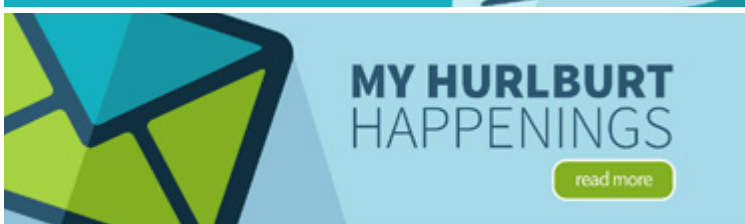

The Youth of the Year (YOY) program in partnership with the Boys and Girls Club of America creates opportunities for military Youth Center participants to receive recognition at the local, state, regional and national levels. The local YOY serves as a role model for other young people in the Youth Center and as a representative of the community and provides opportunities for youth to expand their leadership skills. The local winner may assist volunteering as a coach with the Sports Program at the Youth Center, speak at relevant base events or participate in other community volunteer opportunities. After earning the local title, they go on to compete against other military youth in the state they reside. If they win at state they will continue on to the regional level, and potentially on to the national level. The local YOY completes an interview process with Youth Center management (directors & program coordinators). Once selected they complete their application, and prepare for their three minute YOY speech and interview.

Hurlburt's selectee for 2023 is Hannah Wilson. If you know a teen worthy of this title, pass on the eligibility information to the right and be sure to refer them to <https://www.bgca.net/YOY> for some great tips on how to prepare to compete for the following year!



Applying for Youth of the Year Eligibility Requirements:

The Youth of the Year Leadership Suite available on www.bgca.net/YOY includes a preparation guide to help prepare the candidate.

Application is submitted online by youth center staff.

Age:

Candidates must be no younger than 14 and no older than 18 years of age on January 31 of the competition year.

Identification:

Candidates must complete a military affiliation verification.

Attendance:

Active member and participant of Youth Center for 2 years prior to January 31 of the competition year.



OPERATION KUDOS

Kids Understanding Deployment Operations



Due to the high ops tempo on Hurlburt Field, deployments are a regular occurrence. KUDOS is a deployment education tool for children ages 5-13 of Hurlburt Field, to give them an idea of what their parents experience as part of their deployment process.



Operation KUDOS is an educational event to help build resiliency in military youth by engaging them in activities that simulate the deployment experience. Youth will report to the DCC for a mission brief and process through the deployment line where deployment gear will be issued. They will then be bused to their deployed location (Red Horse Compound) where they will visit “zones” (child-friendly activities & static displays; lunch provided). The event concludes with “Operation HOMECOMING” at the Commando Hangar, welcomed by parents. Static displays are available for the deployers and their families.

Supportive Programs For Our Airmen, Spouses & Their Children

Military members and families endure a whole host of challenges on top of those faced in everyday “normal civilian” life. Today’s Air Force works overtime to take care of Airmen and their families! Often times, just knowing there are resources available can be a saving grace in challenging times. Throughout your military career (active duty or family members alike) you will find a great deal of support through your local Force Support Squadron (1 SOFSS here at Hurlburt Field). We have compiled a list of programs found here, and at most bases, so we ask you to read over the following programs, snap a picture and save it to your favorites or cut out this article and save it for your record. You may not have a personal need right now, but it may come in handy some other time for you or even guide you to help another family who is unaware of assistance when life gets tough.



**FAMILY CHILD CARE (FCC),
(850) 884-4300**

Hurlburt Field FCC offers a variety of child care options for various situations. The info below is an overview and specific rules may apply. Consult with FCC for specific cases:

- **Military Spouse Appointment Child Care (NEW)** - Spouses of Active Duty Military who have appointments may utilize FREE child care with a FCC provider during their scheduled appointment time. Documentation of the appointment required, i.e. a medical appointment or a schedule for a job interview.
- **Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) Respite Child Care** - Short-term care to help reduce the stress associated with caring for an exceptional family member. Available to active duty AF, and Activated Reserve/Guard members. Contact FCC for more details.
- **Subsidy** - Assist families with the utilization of FCC homes by offsetting the fees so they mirror what a family would pay at the on base Child Development Center (CDC). Eligibility: Active duty military member, activated Guard Member or DoD Civilian. All adults living in the household must be working or enrolled in school full-time.
- **Extended Duty** - After-hour care provided when the parent is working an extended duty day beyond the hours of operation at their regular child care facility, temporary shift change not to exceed 3 days, working federal holidays when regular child care facility is closed or rapid mobilization until alternate child care is arranged.
- **FCC 24/7** - Assist parents when regular work schedules are outside normal operating hours: shift workers and personnel required to work overnight, holidays and/or weekends.
- **Deployment and Remote Assignment** - Support when a military member is deployed for a contingency operation or on remote assignment, 16 hours of free care, per month, per child.
- **Home Community Care** - Provides care for members of the Guard and Reserves during scheduled drill weekend.
- **Emergency Medical** - Assists families experiencing a medical emergency with immediate family members.
- **Wounded Warrior Care** - Assist families when Wounded Warrior has medical and/or military appointments.
- **Fallen Warriors** - Assists families attending estate matter appointments for a fallen military family member.
- **PCS for Army, Navy and Marines** - 20 hours of free child care as military member is arriving or departing the base. Contact: FCC office at 884-4300 / or M&FRC at 884-5441 for more info.



**YOUTH PROGRAMS (YP),
(850) 884-6355**

Servicing school-aged youth from 5-18 years old.

- **Anchored4Life** - A peer-to-peer club to connect youth while building transition and resiliency skills. The club provides opportunities for peers to enhance social skills, learn leadership skills, build character, improve self-esteem, and integrate into their community. The program provides a point of contact for our center which means we will always have a lifeline to stability and structure.
- **Youth of The Year** - The best military youth compete through the Military Youth of the Year program, a premier scholarship and recognition program for teen's ages 14-18 offered in partnership with Boys and Girls Clubs of America.
- **Open Rec and Teen Program** - Youth Programs provides positive youth development by supporting the skills, interests, qualities, and abilities of all youth through interactive programming and events.
- **Leadership Clubs** - Torch Club (Pre-teens), Keystone (Teens), and Air Force Teen Council (AFTC).
- **STEAM** (science, technology, art, engineering, and mathematics) - We assist with access to International Space Station tracking, 4-H National Youth STEM Challenge, 3-D Printers, robotics, engineering, and more.
- **National Arts Contest and ImageMakers Photography** - Compete at the local level and submit to Regional and National contests.
- **Youth Sports** - Offering non-competitive clinics/skill development for ages 3-11.
- **Power Hour** - Homework help and volunteer tutoring opportunities for teens.
- **Facebook** - Hurlburt Field Child & Youth
- **Operation MegaPhone** - This dynamic initiative invites teens across the Department of Defense to come together to celebrate, share, and raise awareness about military teen programs. OMP is an initiative designed "by teens, for teens" to connect and build partnerships, raise awareness, and reach out to teens in the community.



**SCHOOL LIAISON PROGRAM (SLP),
(850) 884-6355 or cell (850) 280-5766**

The SLP helps with anything school related. Having issues registering without a current address after PCS? Need assistance with transcript transfers? Transition issues of any sort? Need resources for your military-connected student? The SLP is your one-stop-shop!

- **SLP Connection** - Child and Youth Behavioral Military and Family Life Counselors (CYB-MFLCs) - Provides private and confidential non-medical counseling service, consent from parent or guardian is required. CYB-MFLCs are in the environment to augment services provided by the schools and DoD to include "walk-around" coaching, support and counseling to military children, youth, families and staff. They offer supportive services to all children, both thriving and struggling, with daily activities to build or strengthen resiliency.

FREE DEPLOYMENT CHILD CARE

- 16 Hours Of Care For Pre-Deployment
- 16 Hours Of Care For Each Month Member Is Deployed
- 16 Hours Of Care For Post-Deployment

Hours may be used before, during and up to 60 days upon returning from a deployment. Must be in direct support of contingency operations. Available for dependents (ages 12 and under) of Active Duty, Guard, & Reserve assigned to Hurlburt Field. Call (850) 884-4300 for details

MILITARY & FAMILY READINESS CENTER (M&FRC), (850) 884-5441

The primary focus of the Military & Family Readiness Center (M&FRC) is to support readiness by helping families and single military members adapt to the demands of the military. The center designs, develops and conducts quality of life programs to develop important skills and foster a strong sense of military Community.

- **Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)** - Provides information and assistance to families with special needs: resources, support groups, events, networking opportunities, and a voice.
- **Information & Referral (I&R)** - Connects families with a variety of services and resources on or off base as needed.
- **Discovery Center** - Resource library with information on transition, relocation, deployments, employment, and more. Computer, copy, scan, print, and fax services available.
- **Experiential Training** - Interactive team building and education through group activities.
- **Volunteer Resource Program (VRP)** - Provides recruitment, assessment, and placement of volunteers for on and off-base opportunities.
- **Installation Voting Assistance Officer** - The (IVAO) provides information and help to ensure you are able to exercise your right to vote "wherever you are."
- **Air Force Families Forever (AFFF)** - Support available to family members who have lost an Airman. (Gold Star Families)
- **Financial Readiness Program** - Accredited financial counselors (free), One-on-one budget and debt counseling, identity theft, credit reports, FICO scores, etc. Classes and briefings cover home buying, car buying, TSP/BRS, and credit awareness.
- **Air Force Aid Society (AFAS)** - Emergency financial assistance: provided for basic living expenses, auto repairs, non-covered medical/dental care, and emergency travel. Bundles for Babies (for expecting parents), AFAS education grant, Child Care for PCS.

- **Relocation Assistance Program** - Educate incoming and outgoing families on the PCS/transition process and resources.
- **Welcome Spouse/Coffee and Connections** - An orientation to Hurlburt field programs and services.
- **Newcomers Orientation** - Briefing for all inbound personnel to learn about community resources to help adjust to Hurlburt Field.
- **Child Care For PCS** - 16 hours of free child care (per child) within 60 days of PCS'ing in or out.
- **Sponsorship Training** - Briefing designed to provide sponsors with tools to effectively help transitioning military and families.
- **Key Spouse Program (KSP)** - Volunteers appointed by the commander and trained to help maintain connections between the family and the unit.
- **Personal/Work Life Program (P&WL)** - One-on-one consultations and/or classes on: stress management, team building (workshops upon request), communication (couples and work), parenting concerns, education, adjusting to military life, resiliency techniques and professional growth.
- **Heartlink - Military Spouse 101** - This workshop introduces new military spouses to military traditions, protocol, the mission, resources, etc. A tour of the Deployment Control Center (DCC) is included. Graduating spouses will receive a military coin!
- **Family & Personal Readiness Program** - Provides individual and family assistance before, during and after: deployments, remote tours, TDY's, emergencies, and disasters/evacuations.
- **Hearts Apart** - Support for families during times of separation through: monthly events, weekly email, and information as needed.
- **Employment Assistance Program** - One-on-one consultations based on client needs: resume, interview, and job search assistance for federal and private sector; networking, salary negotiation, and dress for success tips. Provide skills inventories and labor market research and help with school & scholarship applications. Challenges Military Children Face

Military life is filled with unique challenges, many of which are amplified for military children. Regularly moving from state to state or even country to country, or having their friends move away; experiencing at least one parent who must leave for extended training or deployments and more. However, they are not alone, and there are many wonderful resources available to help our military kiddos adapt, build strength and resilience, and develop meaningful connections along the way.

A common occurrence in military families is PCSing, which can cause great distress as kids are torn from an environment they're familiar with and thrown into a new one – expected to start all over again. The M&FRC has PCS materials for all ages and the School Liaison Specialist can help ease the transition from one school to another, before and after a move.

Military kids often deal with a parent who must deploy from time to time, and there are special programs to help children cope with that

separation. The Readiness NCO at the M&FRC has a multitude of resources for kids of all ages before, during, and after deployment – including activity books and Hug-a-Hero doll vouchers. They also coordinate monthly events for deployed-affected families including craft activities, zoo and aquarium experientials, escape rooms, and more. The Library also has a special program where the deploying parent can record themselves reading a book to the child.

Making meaningful connections from location to location can be challenging but there are so many resources to take advantage of, to get out, try new things, and make new friends. The Hurlburt Youth Program has an Open Recreation, Pre-teen, and Teen Center, plus offers various youth sports. The Community Center's Landing Zone has a lounge area, movies, gaming, music, and more. Plus, your unit's Key Spouse(s) can be a wonderful resource for connecting with families with similar demographics or interests.

There are also plenty of resources to help our children learn valuable life skills. The M&FRC can help when it comes to financial readiness, like learning the basics of budgeting and credit; an employment program that can help with looking for scholarships, building resumes, and conducting mock interviews; a volunteer program to find on- and off-base opportunities; and to even get registered to vote once they're old enough. Families with exceptional members, can also receive support navigating the challenges they experience at different stages of life.

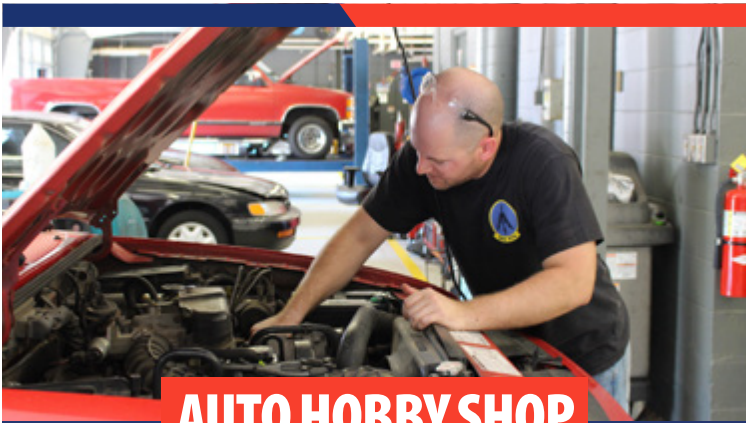

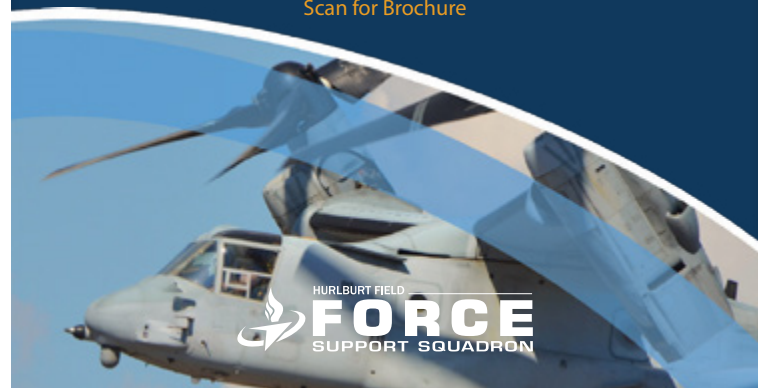
