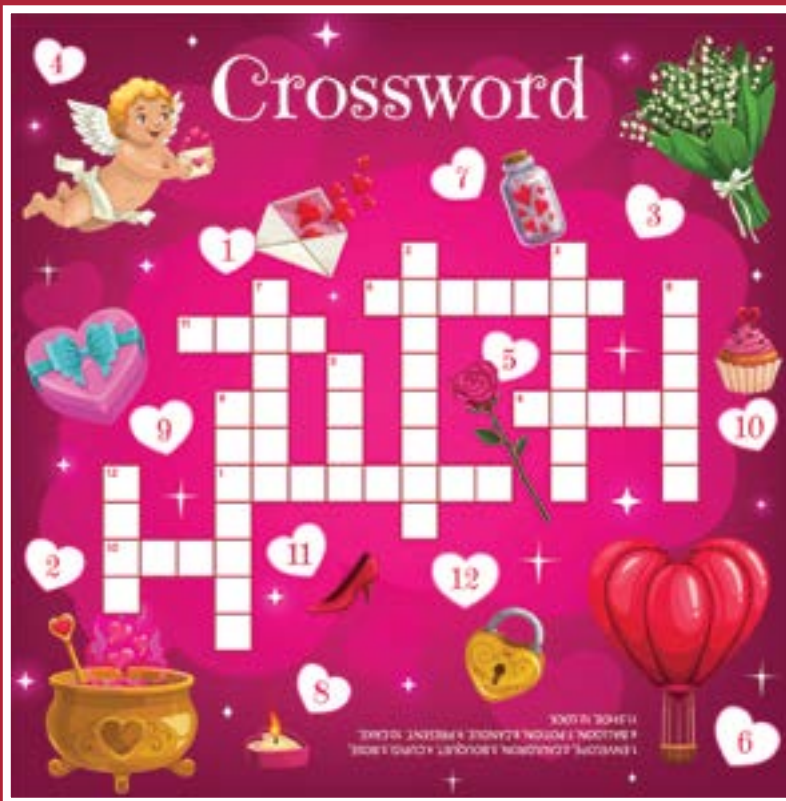

# Want to Know a Foolproof Way to Improve All of Your Relationships?

**B**uild your Emotional Bank Account (EBA) with others. The EBA is a term coined by Dr. Stephen Covey, author of *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People*, to explain how the things we do contribute to or subtract from our relationships with others. EBA is a simple but powerful concept that can quickly improve your relationships. EBA is a metaphor for the amount of trust that exists in a relationship. Our actions can contribute to the currency of trust. Trust is critical to a healthy relationship, especially with close ones.

The more deposits and positive actions you make, the stronger the relationship. But what constitutes a deposit for one person may be a withdrawal to another. You must determine the positive vs. negative for that individual.

Common examples of deposits and withdrawals are:

DEPOSITS	WITHDRAWALS

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Being loyal to them when they aren't around</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Being disloyal; Bad-mouth them</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Apologize sincerely</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Being arrogant and condescending</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Forgive</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hold grudges</li></ul>

Be sincere and consistent in making deposits. Then when you do accidentally make a withdrawal the EBA has enough deposits to withstand that withdrawal.

Close relationships require more deposits. Express appreciation daily. During a conflict ensure that the ratio of positive things to negative is 5:1. So you should say/do 5 positive things for every 1 negative thing. This helps to maintain that positive EBA.

Take a look at your relationships, there are always ways to add to the EBA. Be consistent in making deposits and your level of trust will improve, and in turn, your relationship will flourish.

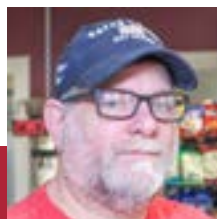

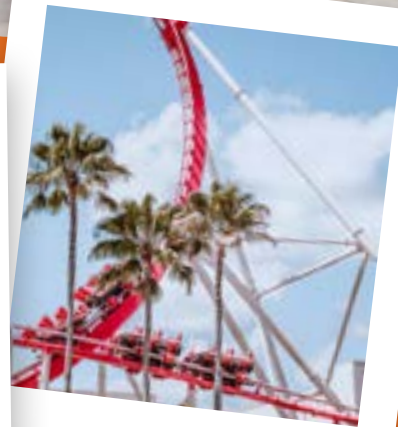

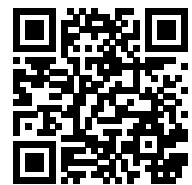

# Daniel's TECH Corner

**Welcome back to Daniel's Tech Corner!  
Want to get some upgrades for that special someone on  
Valentine's Day? Grab a seat and a loved one because this  
month, we're talking about building versus buying a gaming PC!**

This debate has been around for a long time now, but it wasn't until PC gaming became popular in the late 2000s that we've seen this topic discussed more frequently. No matter what side you're on, we will be talking about the pros and cons of building versus buying a gaming PC.

The main argument for buying a PC is convenience. You don't have to worry about opening the computer, potentially frying a part while building, setting up the operating system, the time it takes to put everything together, or troubleshooting any issues you run into. You simply pay, plug, and play. So simple that it warrants paying a little extra to be headache free. The only thing is, sometimes they can slide in some slower performing parts that you won't notice until you've already received the computer. Which is why if you plan on buying, make sure you know the stated specifications that will be in the computer and when you receive it, double check everything to see if you got what you paid for. This has become more rare, as it could be anything from accidentally putting in the wrong part, misreading the specs on the website or them intentionally putting in a different part to save money, either way it has happened in the past so I wanted to make you aware of it.

As for building, the main argument is paying less for better performance. When the chip shortage that effected the production of almost every electronic in 2020 happened, it was cheaper to buy a prebuilt PC because companies would get priority over consumers thus scalpers became a big issue. Production has picked up a lot since then and it's starting to be more cost effective to build a PC again. A benefit to building is you get to choose exactly which parts go into the computer. Prefer one brand over another? No problem. Do a lot of video

or photo editing and less gaming? Spend more on a better processor and RAM and spend less on the graphics card. You also have more flexibility with your budget. You can build a good gaming PC that will play most titles on medium to high graphics for around \$700-\$900 in comparison to a prebuilt with the same specs that could run you upwards of \$1000-\$1500, and you can buy the parts over time instead of one big payment. One payday you buy the case, the next a motherboard, then a processor, and so on until you have a complete computer without breaking the bank.

If you are planning on building a computer, [PCPartPicker.com/list](https://www.pcpartpicker.com/list) is a great website that will help you find compatible parts from reliable online retailers to get you the cheapest price without having to search. It has a list of all the parts you will need and it will tell you any issues with the parts selected. As for putting everything together, there are a lot of videos you can find online that will help guide you through building a PC. I recommend following the guide that Linus Tech Tips has on YouTube as they walk you through picking out the parts, getting and inspecting the parts for damage, putting everything together, installing an operating system and any troubleshooting you're going to be doing. All in a convenient timestamped video for you to follow and skip to the parts you need.

I hope this shed some light on the choices you have when looking for a new gaming PC.



# HURLBURT FIELD Food Service Operation

---

*At the heart of it all*

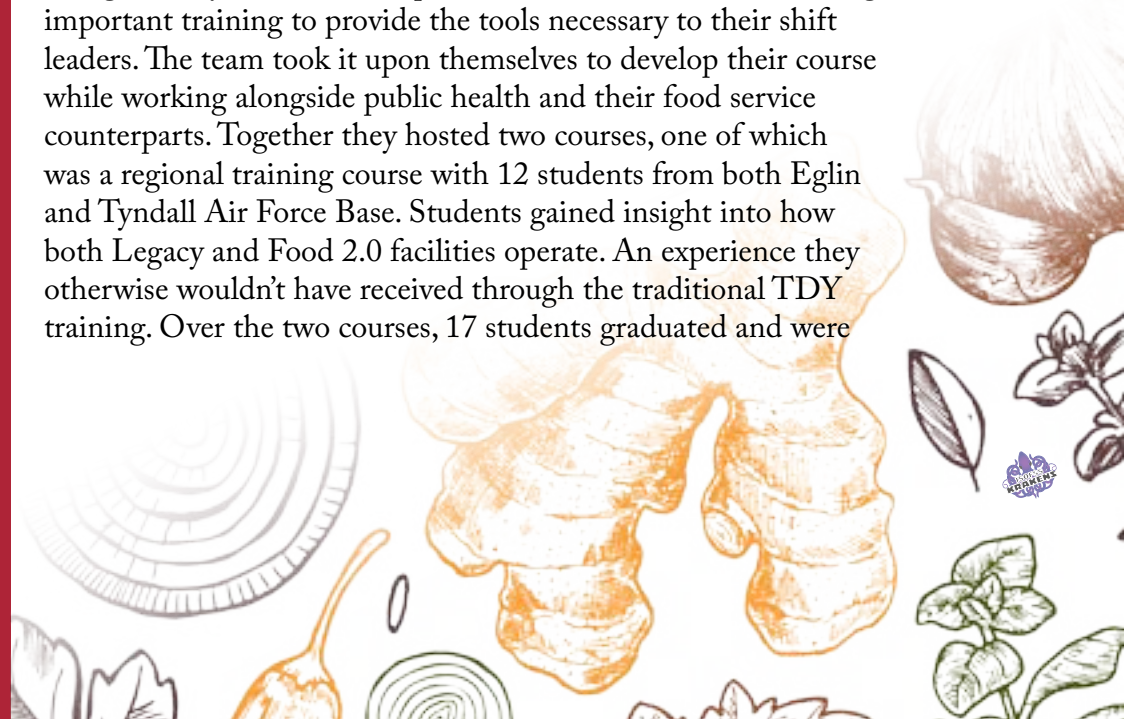


Hurlburt Field's dining scene is ever evolving and over the years we've seen many changes across the installation. One thing that has remained the same since 1955 is the Reef Dining Facility. The operation itself has grown and developed since its date of opening, including the opening of its sister operation, the Riptide Dining Facility in 2005.

Currently, the food service team assigned to Hurlburt Field is led by four Technical Sergeants. The team is made up of 29 Active-Duty personnel and 34 contractors, split between the Reef Dining Facility and the Riptide Dining Facility.

The food service team works diligently to support 582,000 customers annually over three meal periods. Their storeroom operation, which consists of three personnel, submits and receives over 520 subsistence orders annually, totaling nearly \$600,000, producing over 90 menu items daily. Currently, all active duty and TDY members are permitted to dine at either Dining Facility. The food service team supports a population of 350 essential mess stations (ESM) for the customers.

In January 2022, the food service team directed their attention to improve their training. They were presented with many limitations brought on by the Covid-19 pandemic when it came to accessing important training to provide the tools necessary to their shift leaders. The team took it upon themselves to develop their course while working alongside public health and their food service counterparts. Together they hosted two courses, one of which was a regional training course with 12 students from both Eglin and Tyndall Air Force Base. Students gained insight into how both Legacy and Food 2.0 facilities operate. An experience they otherwise wouldn't have received through the traditional TDY training. Over the two courses, 17 students graduated and were





presented with their red shift leader hats, an Air Force chef white tradition. The students walked away with the knowledge of how to properly oversee meal production and serving.

In February 2022, the Reef Dining Facility was offered the opportunity to improve its facility through an equipment recapitalization valued at over \$270,000. This improvement required coordination through base civil engineers and contractor engagement, and is scheduled to occur within the coming months. It will replace the serving line and salad bar and introduce a smoothie bar, and workstation.

In March 2022, the food service team recognized an opportunity to expand on their operations improvements. A new schedule was created to ensure the food service operations continued to improve while a weekly details team was developed. Each week a team of five personnel was led by a team lead and assigned tasks for facility. From detailed cleaning and storage reorganization to cosmetic improvements both inside

and outside of their two facilities, the teams made great strides to improve the overall aesthetic of their facilities as well as provided leadership opportunities and experience for their newer team leads.

The food service team didn't stop there! When Covid-19 limitations eased, the team grasped the opportunity to hold their **Chef of the Quarter** competitions. These competitions brought out the chef in everyone. They were made up of contestants from across the installation and judged by installation leadership. Planning for each competition took approximately two months of coordination. It required manning adjustments, marketing requests, contractor support, and wing coordination. Over the course of the year, they had 19 contestants and 80 guests. Each competition had its own theme and brought in three surprise ingredients the contestants had to determine how to incorporate into their meals. The judges made their determinations based on presentation, creativity, texture, and palatability.

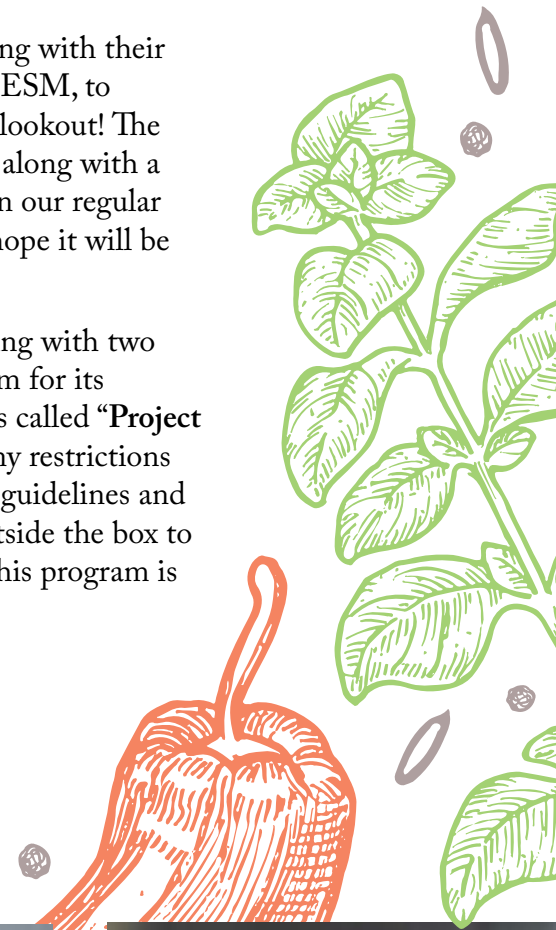
Additionally, the food service operation provided support to 26 special operations teams last year alone through MRE aid and



subsistence ordering. They liaised with the Mission Support Team to provide the necessary supplies and continue the training of the Air Force Special Operations multi-capable airman initiative. Furthermore, nine team members are currently assigned to the Mission Sustainment Team, bringing their capabilities to the mission

Coming June of 2023, the food service team is coordinating with their ESM monitors to consolidate birthdays of their essential ESM, to implement a quarterly birthday meal program. Be on the lookout! The quarterly birthday meals will be accompanied by a theme along with a specialized cake and menu items customers will not see on our regular menu. They are excited to bring this program to life and hope it will be received well by our airmen.

Additionally, the food service team is currently coordinating with two local restaurants to create a **short-term internship** program for its personnel to broaden their chef toolboxes. This program is called “**Project Cooking.**” As an Air Force food operation, they have many restrictions on food enhancement due to the Air Force recipe system guidelines and M-Neat requirements, but the team continues to look outside the box to improve their customers’ experience. Implementation of this program is expected to begin in April 2023.



On 5 January, sustainment flight leadership was notified that after a three-year lapse, the Food Service team was selected as a finalist for the **John L. Hennessey Award**, also known as 'Best Dining Facility in the Air Force.' The team will be evaluated over a two-day period by an inspection team from the Air Force Services Center in five categories: kitchen operations, serving and dining operations, training, personnel and readiness, sanitation and repair maintenance, and management. This is the **highest award an Air Force Food Operation** can obtain. The food service team is expected to undergo this evaluation in February 2023.

We have had some great improvements over the last year and are continuing to engage the local community to create opportunities for more. Our customers are our number one priority and their feedback, whether positive or negative, is necessary and encouraged. **Positive feedback** is great to receive as it means that we are on the right track, but negative feedback is also valued because it provides additional opportunities for growth and improvement.

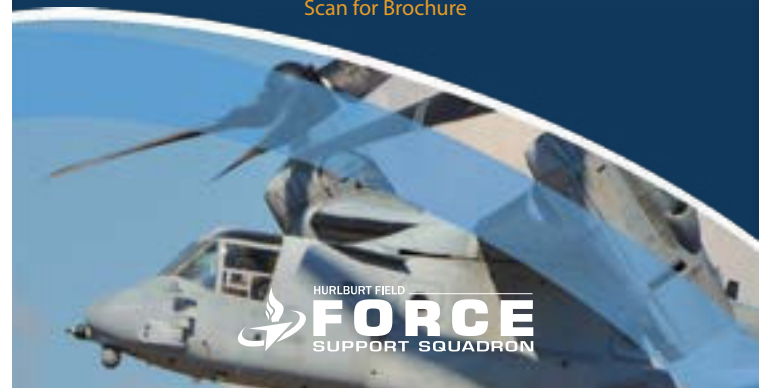
