A deep dive into Hurlburt's R4R Programs featuring Deployed Affected Program and RecOn Programs this month

Recharge for Resiliency (R4R) is an Air Force wide program for Force Support Squadron morale, welfare and recreation (MWR) activities. R4R seeks to serve single or unaccompanied airmen, airmen preparing for deployments/redeployment and families, and units. R4R provides resources that foster unit cohesion, culture, mission, and a sense of community among Airmen and their families. There are four programs provided for a specific eligible audience. This month we will focus on Deployed Affected Program (DAP) and RecOn with Single Airman Program and UNITE featured next month.



Hurlburt DAP is a program for spouses and families who have active-duty Airmen deployed from Hurlburt Field. The purpose of this program is to allow these spouses and families to build a sense of community with others facing the same hardships of deployment. In this free program, they can attend activities throughout the year that not only bring them closer together but also offer educational, recreational, historical, and cultural experiences. Even after your active-duty Airman returns from deployment, spouses and families can continue participating in these activities for a year to help reintegrate and ease the transition while creating new memories and having fun together. MSgt Brooke Scott, the Readiness NCO at M&FRC who oversees Hurlburt Field's DAP program says, "The program helps the family members left behind, it gives them a healthy outlet to cope – and sometimes when the deployed member returns, it can be awkward. It gives them a nice and safe opportunity to bond as a family

again." To participate in these activities, you can join the Hurlburt Hearts Apart Facebook group. Each activity is posted in the group where you can sign-up. To be eligible, spouses and families must show deploy affected orders from Hurlburt Field. Hurlburt DAP takes pride in offering a range of activities for all demographics because they know not all deployment families have children. Some fun activities that have been enjoyed in the past are parasailing, painting with goats, glass bottom boat rides, Surge Adventure Park, Gulf Breeze Zoo, and paint and sips.

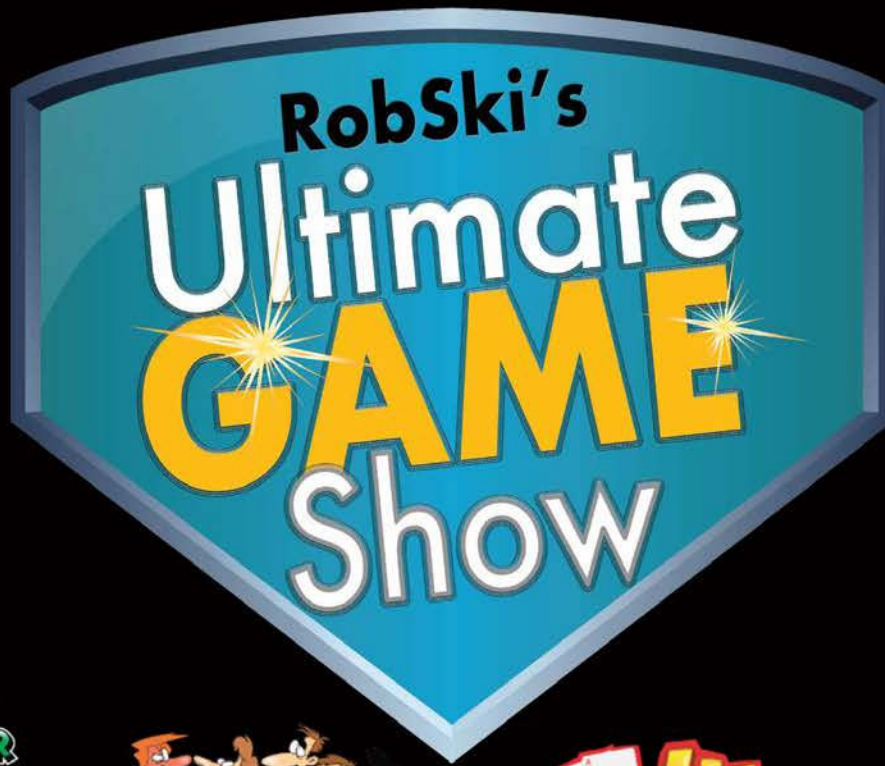

Another TAX Season is Upon Us: *Are You Prepared?*

Tax season has arrived and DFAS wants to ensure you are prepared. Now is the best time to double check everything is correct regarding your account so there are no hiccups when you need to file.

The best tool DFAS offers for ensuring a smooth tax season is myPay (mypay.dfas.mil). The most important step to take now is to login to your myPay account, and check and update your mailing address.

An easy, online stop for your tax season needs, myPay offers printing or downloading of your tax statements for your retired pay or your annuity pay. You can print/download your current year tax statement, as well as prior year 1099Rs (up to four prior years for retirees and up to two prior years for annuitants). If you have them, you can also print/download IRS form 1095B, as well as the documentation for any taxable travel income received.

You'll have much earlier access to your tax documents through myPay. 1099Rs are generally available in myPay in late December, while paper copies aren't mailed until mid-to-late January.

If you haven't logged in to myPay in a while, this is a good time to log in and update your password, before the busy tax season.

Now is also a good time to check and adjust your tax withholding, if needed.

The IRS has an online Tax Withholding Estimator to help you determine how much tax you need to have withheld. The calculator helps

taxpayers estimate if the right amount is withheld from their income to cover their tax liability. The estimator uses a simple, six-step question-and-answer format using information like marital or filing status, income, withholding, adjustments, deductions and credits. www.irs.gov/individuals/tax-withholding-estimator

It's easy to change the amount withheld for federal taxes on the myPay site by clicking on the Federal Withholding link.

Once there, click on the yellow pencil to go to the edit page. On the edit page, you can also enter information about multiple jobs, change your number of dependents, add additional income, make additional deductions or have extra tax withheld. The blue bar tells you when you can expect the changes to go into effect.

Retirees can start, stop, or change their State Income Tax Withholding (SITW), but only if that state has an agreement in place allowing DFAS to withhold state tax. In some states, but not all, portions of your retired pay may be tax exempt. Because tax obligations vary from state to state, contact your state's department of revenue regarding taxability of your military retired pay.

Any changes to SITW must be made in writing, by submitting a DD 2866 form (www.esd.whs.mil/Portals/54/Documents/DD/forms/dd/dd2866.pdf) or by using myPay. DFAS can only withhold income tax for one state at a time and the designated state must have signed the standard written SITW agreement with the Department of Defense.

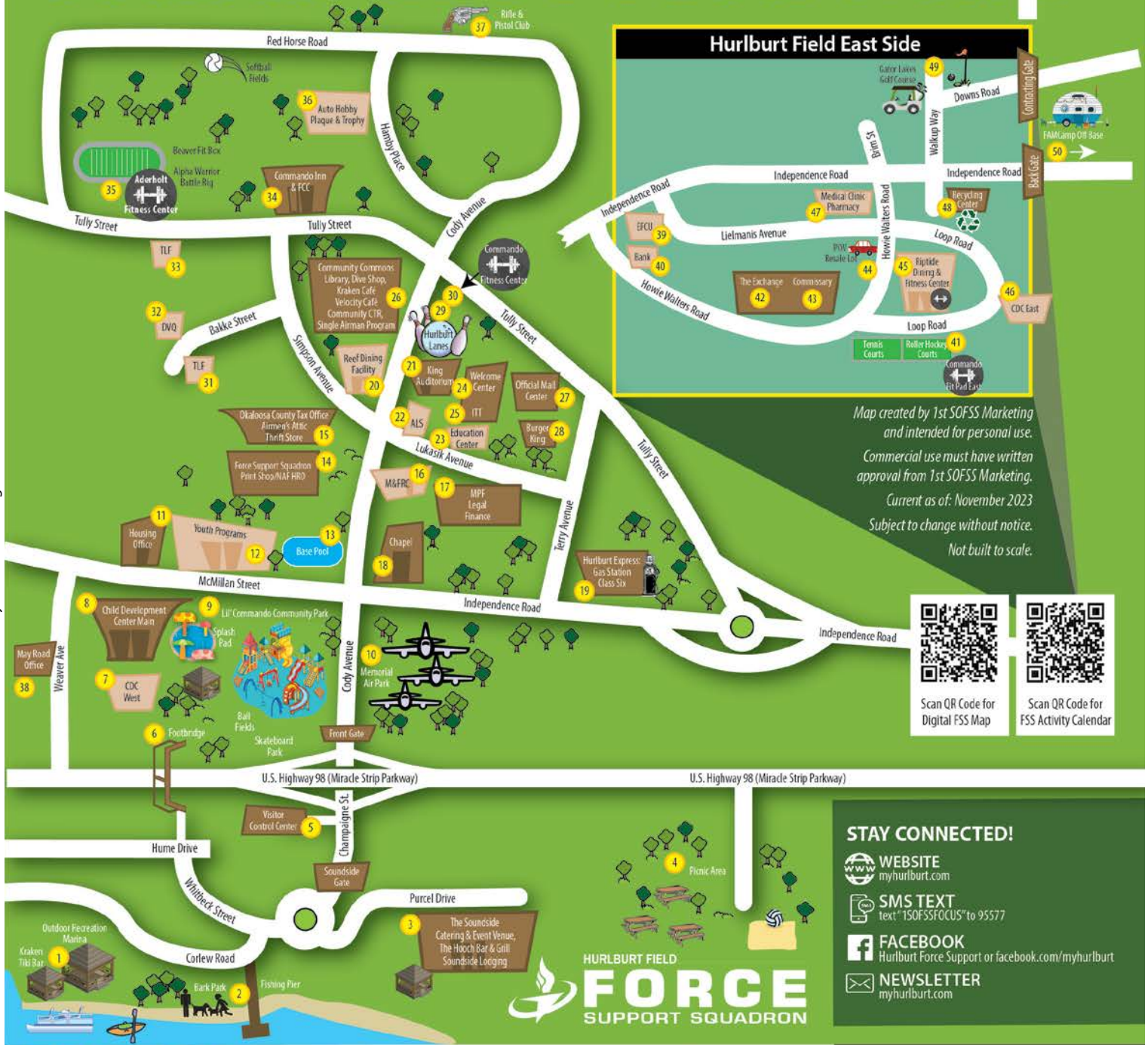

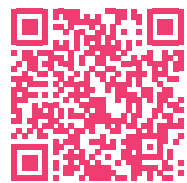
