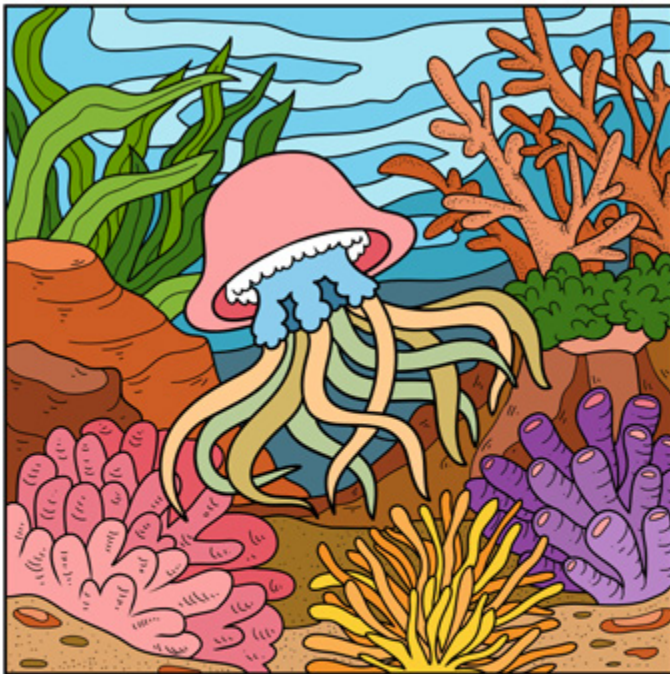

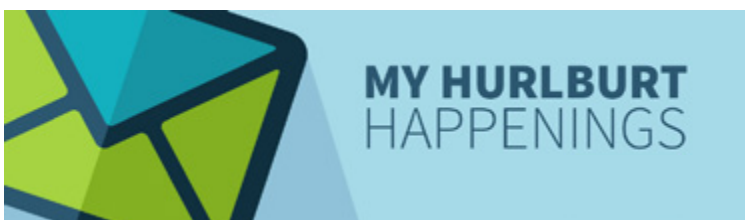

THE BENEFITS OF ISOLATION FLOAT TANKS

While humans are social creatures, we also need time to ourselves to recharge and regenerate. Finding time for yourself may be a bit challenging, having to work full-time and then going home to a busy life with your family. Float tanks can be very beneficial for when you are feeling a little stressed in your life, needing a new way of calming down your mind and body, or when you are looking for some quiet alone time.



Float tanks, also known as sensory deprivation tanks, provide Restricted Environmental Stimulation Therapy (REST). The float tanks were first invented in the 1950s by Dr. Jay Shurley and Dr. John Lilly. Float tanks come in a range of sizes, but the most common tank is typically around 8' long and 4.5' wide, allowing you to stretch out. The main goal of the float tank is to create an experience with minimal sensory stimulation that allows you to ease your mental anxiety and relax muscle tension. The fluid helps relax your muscles when floating with the help of the Epsom salts and water solution. (The tank contains enough water for you to float on your back, with the water heated to skin temperature). The high salt concentration of the tank also allows you to float easily on your back with your head partially underwater. Once you enter the float tank, simply close the door to create a dark, quiet, and meditative environment. The tank is also soundproof, preventing noise from causing distractions.

With a lack of external stimulation, this allows you to close your eyes, focus on breathing, and empty your mind. The relaxation may help with a variety of issues, ranging from anxiety and stress to physical aches and pains. When it comes to the physical benefits of float therapy, patrons may see improvements with conditions like: chronic pain from arthritis, muscle tension, whiplash symptoms such as a stiff neck, immune function, high blood pressure, recovery after injuries, fatigue, insomnia and other sleep disturbances. Since Epsom salts are high in magnesium, they can provide relief from migraines and stress of aches or pains in the body. In addition to physical health benefits of float therapy, there are mental health benefits as well. Float therapy has been shown to reduce the symptoms of depression, anxiety, high stress levels, and PTSD. Many people with PTSD have reported that the float tank creates a safe place for them to process traumatizing memories, as well as mitigating anxiety or depression. Many of the float tank sessions tend to be 30 minutes to an hour long. Nothing is wrong with visiting a float tank every day, but it is said that the best results occur when a float tank session is done at least one to two times per week.

The float tanks located at Hurlburt Field are available to all DoD ID Cardholders to use year-round. Your float session will last one hour for \$40. The session includes a private tank, calming music, LED lighting, and your choice of ear plugs or a floating head rest so your ears will not be exposed to the water. It is important before entering to shower with sulfate-free shampoos and body wash, to wash away any fragrances, hair products, body oils, etc., that will affect the water. Make sure you have a light meal and avoid caffeine at least 4 hours prior in order to have the most relaxing experience. For proper flotation attire, both men and women are advised to wear snug fitting swimsuits or compression shorts and are recommended to refrain from wearing loose shorts/swimsuits, as they can interfere with the floating.

Flotation therapy has been shown to be beneficial for many people. When used properly, the float tank sessions could help relieve physical and mental stress you may be facing and give you a sense of focus and optimism. Sensory deprivation tanks are generally safe, but it may be a good idea to speak to your doctor before using one. Call to schedule an appointment.

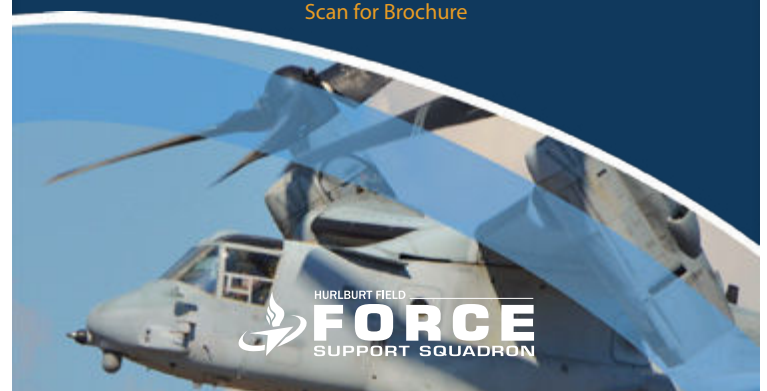

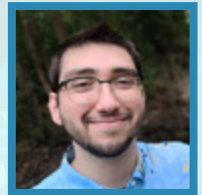

Welcome back to the place where we talk all things tech!
This month we're going to be talking about Electric Vehicles (EVs)!



The Benefits

We live on a very beautiful planet and it would be great if we tried to keep this world spinning for as long as possible. With 278,063,737 (approximately 3,000,000 being electric) motor vehicles in the United States alone, we are putting a lot of emissions into the air that could cause issues for future generations.

This is where Electric Vehicles come into play. EVs have no emissions to worry about and keep the air more clean. They're not only environmentally friendly, they are some of the best performing vehicles out there in terms of efficiency, quickness, and reliability. Since there is no engine to worry about, some EVs come with an 8-12 year warranty on the powertrain. All you have to do is get the brakes and tires changed, when needed. Some EVs also come with some pretty hefty tax write-offs as well. I know what you're thinking... "Daniel, if electric is the future, then why don't we all just switch now?" Well, with all the good, comes some bad.

Still in the Early Days

Since EVs are still in their infancy, there is a lot of prototyping going on with them, which means the price is significantly higher than the gas-powered equivalent. This also means that the charging system kinks haven't been worked out yet. Most EVs will take anywhere from 30 minutes to one and a half hours to charge up to 80% from empty. For some people this is ideal for road trips so they can have that break every 200-450 miles but for most, this would make for a bad road trip vehicle since you have to go out of your way to find a charger, as well as wait the additional time for it to charge. Those are the two main drawbacks for EVs. If you're looking at getting an EV and you think they're too expensive to warrant making that purchase or you take a lot of road trips, then it may be worth it to wait another 3-7 years to let things develop.



The Future is Bright

Tesla is currently working on a way to replace the lithium in their batteries with a material that is significantly easier and cheaper to obtain, which could drop the price on all EVs, once the new technology is adopted by the other auto manufacturers. As more charging stations are being built and charging technology advances, we may see more EVs taking cross-country road trips in the coming years. Some bigger EVs that have come out and are more family oriented, are the Rivian R1S/R1T, Ford F150 Lightning, Mustang Mach-E, Chevrolet Blazer EV, and so many more vehicles that are being brought to the EV market.

On another note, I will be going on Parental leave starting this month so there may not be a tech corner for a few months. With that being said, I'd like to wish a Happy Father's day to all the Fathers out there. You are all doing the best you can and that is all we can ask for as a society.

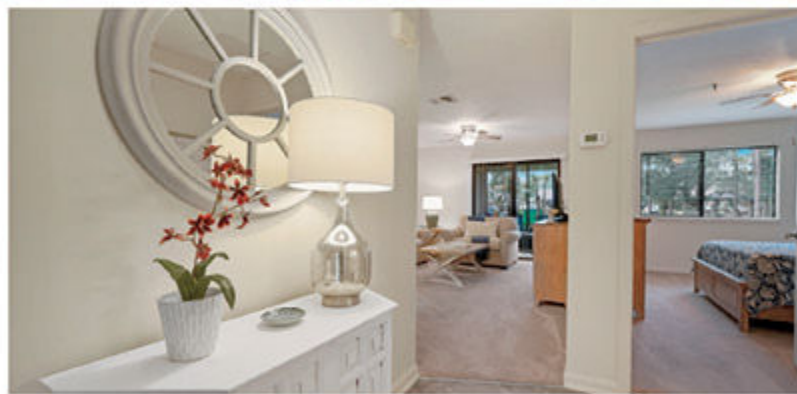

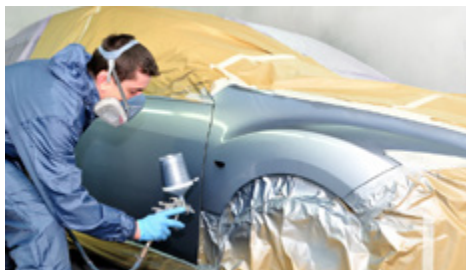

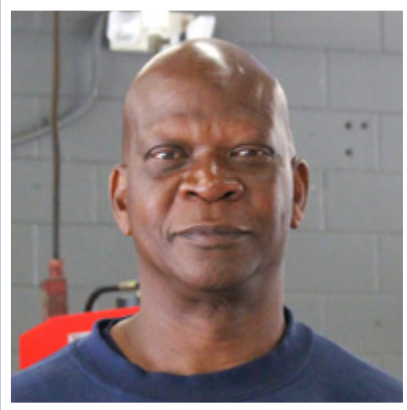

What To Do When Life Changes



DEFENSE FINANCE AND ACCOUNTING SERVICE MUST KNOW WHEN LIFE CHANGES OCCUR

- Retirees must keep DFAS (Defense Finance and Accounting Service) informed whenever changes happen that could affect retired pay.
- Life-changing events such as marriages, divorces, births, etc., must be reported directly to Retired and Annuitant Pay as soon as possible.

Events can also be reported by using myPay or calling 1-800-321-1080.

The following are examples of life changing events and how these events could impact your account:

1. **Marriage** – Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP), arrears of pay beneficiary federal income tax.
2. **Divorce** – SBP, arrears of pay beneficiary, federal income tax.
3. **Death of a spouse** – SBP, arrears of pay beneficiary, federal income tax.
4. **Birth of a child** – SBP, arrears of pay beneficiary, federal income tax.
5. **Change of address** – (even if just for the winter months) general correspondence delivery, 1099-R and retiree account statement mailing, state income tax withholding, receipt of Afterburner and make sure that you put your apartment number.
6. **Opening, changing or closing a bank account** – net pay and allotment direct deposit.
7. **Changing the email address stored in myPay** – myPay account change notifications, receipt of Afterburner, myPay notifications for 1099-R and retiree account statement availability.
8. **Paying off and/or closing an insurance policy** – net pay and allotment direct deposit.
9. **By keeping information current in myPay and submitting the appropriate paperwork when a life-changing event occurs**, retirees will help DFAS improve the service it provides.
10. **By reporting these events when they happen**, beneficiaries will have fewer issues and concerns to resolve later.

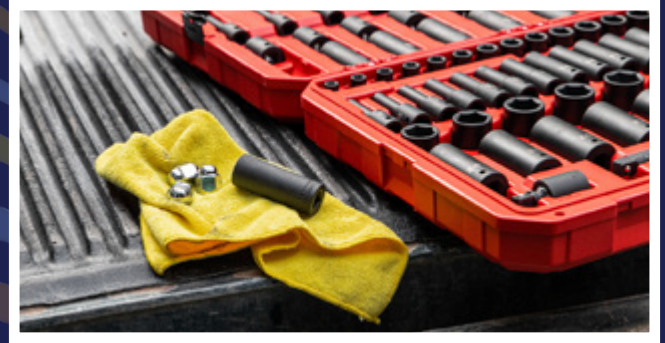
