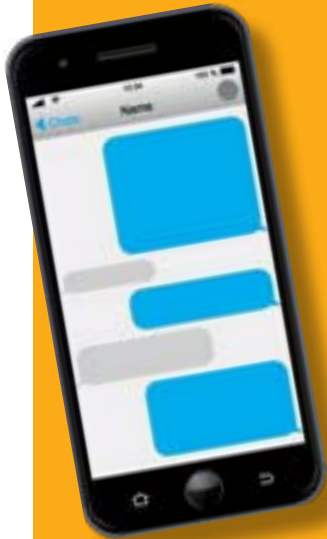

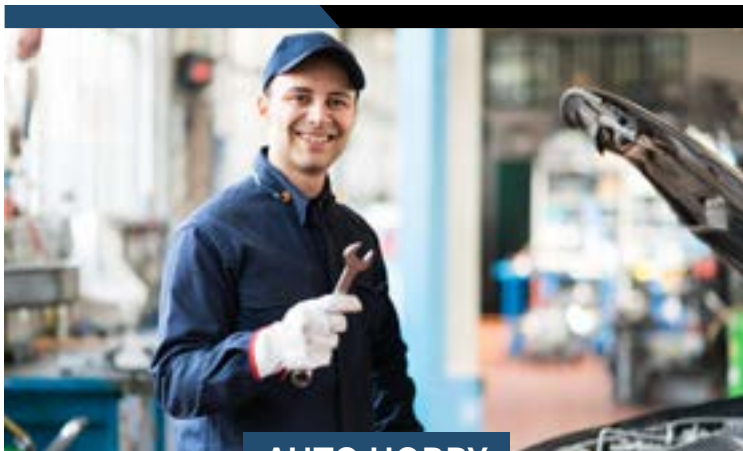

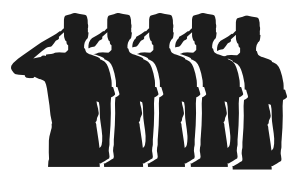

# MY Veterans Day

**W**hat does being a military family mean to you? When someone asks me that question I really don't know how to respond, because in truth the military life is the only life I've ever known. I was born to parents who both served, my dad retiring; only for me to join. It was in the service I met my husband and began a family of our own. I've also watched my brother serve from afar.

However, when I think about my military family and what being one means, I don't really think of my own, but I think of the "family" and experiences we've acquired along the way. The friends of my parents who became grandparent stand-ins for me, and the friends of my parents that became aunts and uncles to me. It's the people from other walks of life, different states, and countries, that shaped my life in ways that would have never been shaped if I had been raised in a typical civilian community.

I don't have memories of being rooted in one place, not a house that built me, like Miranda Lambert so familiarly describes in her hit song; my life has been built in boxes and furniture with lingering numbered tape on the sides. Sometimes it can be hard on the heart, no real place truly feeling like home, but that also means I have the resiliency of rerouting and carrying on.

It's the family that's always been where I've been, stood where I've stood, and continued to be a constant despite the ever change. I could choose to feel the burden of military life's ever change, but I'd rather reminisce on all the blessings this military family life has given me, and that has meant everything to me while standing in the trenches of life. ■

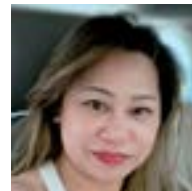

Effective 24 September 2022

### Filling new prescriptions

- **[Preferred] In-person option:** Fill out activation slip and place in drop box in our lobby
- **Telephone option:** Call (850) 881-2133, Option 2 (expect longer wait times)
- **We can no longer accept paper prescriptions:** all new prescriptions must be sent electronically by your provider  
*\*Some exceptions may apply*

### Medication Refills

- No change to process, call 850-881-5835
- ScriptCenter available in BX Lobby for after-hours **refill** pickup (except refrigerated items or narcotics)

**Wait Times:** Next day pick up for non-urgent prescriptions, same day pickup for acute needs.

- It takes pharmacy staff roughly 3 times longer to process prescriptions in MHS GENESIS
- Wait times will improve as staff gains familiarity with new system.

**Text Alerts:** Sign up for text message alerts to receive prescription updates (requires your cell number and carrier)

**Hours of operation:** No changes - Open Weekdays from 0730-1630

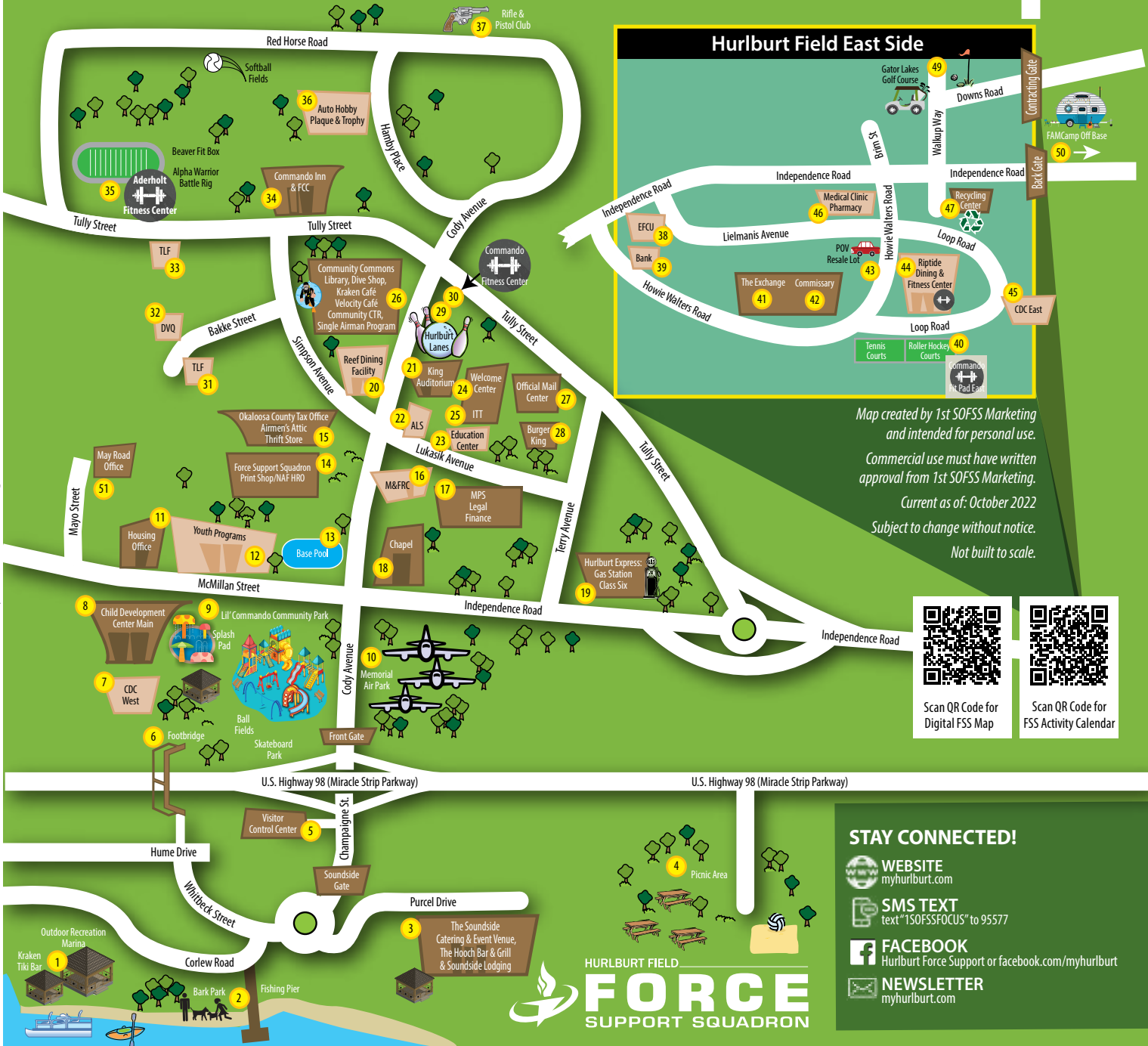
