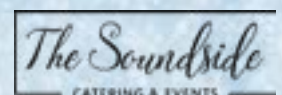

This month we're going to be talking about Artificial Intelligence (AI)

## What can AI do?

Artificial Intelligence is taking off right now. What started as the simple idea of computers being faster, cheaper, more accessible, and able to store more information than a human, has advanced far enough to the point where sometimes we can't tell if there's a person behind it or an AI.

You may see some QR code art placed around the FSS facilities on base that utilizes the same prompt based AI art generation.

Voicify AI has your back, simply look through the voice models that the AI has spent hundreds of hours training to sound like your favorite celebrity. Once you have chosen the desired voice, you can provide a Youtube link or your own audio file, and AI will do the rest, giving you that new version you were looking for. Another thing AI can do is alter photos and videos, and it does a really good job. Which makes you start to question, what's real and what's AI? Artificial Intelligence can do so much and the technology has advanced so far that some experts say by the year 2050 the primary mode of transportation will be autonomous vehicles. You can sit back and relax while your car takes you from stop to stop, making long road trips a breeze. Alright, enough rambling, it's time for you to go ask ChatGPT to recommend what you should have for dinner and get to the Commissary! While you're there, keep an eye out for our QR code art. ## A LOOK INTO HURLBURT FIELD'S HONOR GUARD

The U.S. Air Force Honor Guard was established in 1948, with a mission to “deliver premier ceremonial honors, inspire the nation, and represent all Airmen and Guardians of the world.” Here at Hurlburt Field Honor Guard, they take pride in upholding that mission. These men and women sign up to be the faces of the Air Force during military life changes. Whether it's retiree or veteran ceremonies, a change of command or an Active-Duty funeral, they execute the mission with extreme poise and precision to honor their service.





The Hurlburt Field Honor Guard operates as an eight-month program with an extensive two-month training course. During these two-months, Airmen learn everything from flag folding and rifling to the smallest details like walking in formation and uniform presentation. After completing the initial training, the Airmen that graduate will have the honor of being able to perform every type of ceremony.

The journey it takes to get there isn't easy. Under their motto, "Sharp, crisp, and motionless," these Airmen spend hours practicing techniques to ensure accuracy and unison to meet that standard. Hurlburt Field Honor Guard Program Manager MSgt Jerrel Williams understands the dedication and hard work these Airmen put in. "I have 100 percent confidence that they can go out and perform to the standard that I expect, and they expect. It's the very small details that we work on that presents a the most professional ceremony."

It's no easy feat to present honors to those that have served and continue to serve. It can be an emotional experience, handing a flag over to a service member's next of kin or presenting colors for a change of command. That's why one of Honor Guard's key principles is "bearing," as in, bearing mistakes and emotions to push through adversities to complete the Honor Guard mission. They are not only representing the Air Force with pride, but also giving military families and service members a ceremony that dignifies their service.

When you join Honor Guard you become a part of something bigger than yourself. The bedrock of the program is the sense of community that's being built. It's a team effort and Guardsmen rely on each other to be in sync. When one of them misses a mark, it can be detrimental to the whole team, but it's the community within Honor Guard and respect they have for each other that helps them be the best they can

be. They aren't just representing the Air Force and Hurlburt Field, but each other. Being a part of Honor Guard teaches life lessons and helps these Airmen grow. They not only learn to put their best foot forward at ceremonies but also in their Air Force careers and beyond.

"Being able to take everything that I've learned in my 18 years and pour it into these Airmen- I want to make them more successful Airmen and Guardsmen, but also help them out as a person down the road".

At Hurlburt Field Pharmacy, we understand that your time is valuable. That's why we're dedicated to providing efficient and top-notch pharmacy services to our esteemed military community. Here's a glimpse into our pharmacy services and procedures that help us serve you better.

#### Efficiency in Action:

With an average of 350 patients visiting us daily for prescription pickup, we are committed to keeping your wait time short, averaging just 15 minutes. We fill approximately 700 prescriptions & interact with 525 patients each day, doing our best to ensure that you quickly get the medications you need. In August 2023, we filled 59% of all prescriptions in under 30 minutes and 78% in less than 1 hour, showcasing our dedication to timely care.

#### Activation is Key:

For prescriptions from off-base providers, requesting your medication ahead of time is essential. With over 2,000 to 3,000 off-base prescriptions received daily, we need your help to streamline the process. You can quickly activate your prescription in under a minute by completing our online request form at [tinyurl.com/hurlburtRx](https://tinyurl.com/hurlburtRx). Alternatively, you can call us at (850) 881-2133, although online activation is preferable due to shorter wait times.

#### Prescriptions from Hurlburt Field or Eglin AFB Providers Processed Automatically:

To save you time, we process all prescriptions received from military providers automatically and they are typically ready for pickup within 1 hour.

#### Convenient Refills:

Our automated line at (850) 881-5835, as indicated on your prescription label, provides a hassle-free option for refills with no wait time. If you don't have your Rx number handy, you can also fill out an online request at [tinyurl.com/hurlburtRx](https://tinyurl.com/hurlburtRx). Additionally, our Rx pickup locker located in the BX lobby offers a quick and convenient way to retrieve your refills without waiting in line. You can select this option when calling in your refills to the automated line above.

#### Workload and Responsibility:

Our commitment to you goes beyond just efficiency. Annually, we spend \$6M on medications to ensure the health and well-being of our community and work with your provider to make sure the medication you receive is safe and effective.

Hurlburt Field Pharmacy remains devoted to providing timely, efficient, and excellent pharmaceutical care to our military retirees. We thank you for your trust in our services and look forward to continuing to meet your pharmaceutical needs.

We encourage responsible medication disposal through our MedSafe drop box, conveniently located just outside the pharmacy. To make our community safer, we collect over 30 pounds of unused pharmaceuticals weekly.
