## Mission

To assist DoD military and civilian personnel in balancing the competing demands of the accomplishment of the DoD mission and family life by managing and delivering a system of quality, available and affordable programs and services for eligible youth.

## Food Served

Nutritious meals and snacks are served daily. The SAC is a participant in the USDA Food program. Due to USDA regulations, outside food may not be brought into the facility. We specially prepare food for children with dietary restrictions.

## Staff to Child Ratio

To ensure safety and manage ability of all children, the staff to child ratio will not exceed 2:24 throughout the building. For activities requiring higher supervision (swimming, wood-working & cooking) we adhere to a 1:6 ratio. Field trips are supervised at a 1:12 ratio per group.

## Special Needs Children

A Child and Youth Inclusion Action Team comprised of a multidisciplinary group of professionals meet to assess reasonable accommodations for children/youth with identified developmental and/or medical requirements.



## Enrollment Policies & Cost

### Eligibility

The following categories of personnel may utilize Hurlburt School Age Care (SAC): Active duty military personnel assigned to or supporting Hurlburt Field, active duty military personnel and their dependents who are not assigned to or supporting Hurlburt Field, DoD civilian employees and contractors assigned to Hurlburt Field. Eligibility is verified with proper identification.

### Priorities for enrollment

Priority for care is administered through Military Child Care (MCC) based on the following eligibility requirements:

Single or Dual Active Duty Members; Single or Dual Guard or Reserve Members on Active Duty or Inactive Duty Training Status; and Service Members with a Fulltime Working Spouse

Active Duty Members or Guard or Reserve Members on Active Duty or Inactive Duty Training Status with Part-Time Working Spouse or a Spouse Seeking Employment

*Priority 1 D*

Active Duty Members or Guard or Reserve Members on Active Duty or Inactive Duty Training Status with a Spouse Enrolled in a Post- Secondary Institution on a FullTime Basis

DoD Civilians (2nd child discount not available)

#### 3rd Priority:

Space Available (2nd child discount not available)

School year fees are based on what school the youth attends and total household income.

Fees are calculated based on DoD guidelines according to the Military Child Care Act of 1996 and are updated annually. Please contact the front office for more information.

The hourly rate of care is \$8.

There is an additional transportation fee for those youth traveling to/from Navarre Schools. While patrons can choose frequency of payment during school year (weekly, bi-weekly, bi-monthly and monthly), payments during camps and summer are charged on a weekly basis.

There is a late fee of \$5 dollars a day per family.

We are open for all Okaloosa & Santa Rosa county public schools on early release and all day outs. Additional fees are charged for early release, half days and all day outs.
