Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood

Get Fee Assistance for Community Child Care

As a military parent, you want access to affordable, quality child care.

When child care is unavailable on the installation, you may be eligible to receive fee assistance through Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood, or MCCYN. The Defense Department offers fee assistance to reduce the out-of-pocket expense of child care in the community.



Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood: Details and Eligibility

- Fee assistance supports service members unable to access installation child care services.
- MCCYN serves deployed and active-duty personnel, reserve and Guard members, and DOD civilian employees.
- Child care providers are state licensed, adhere to national or state accreditation standards and have compliant background checks.
- Fee assistance paid to eligible providers is based on the service member's total family income.
