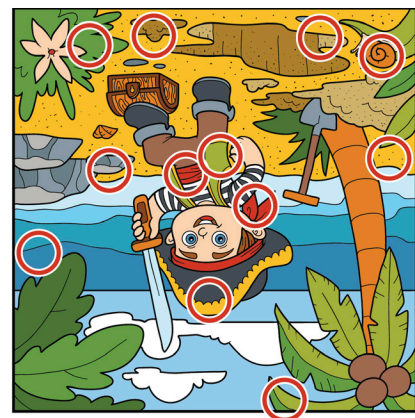

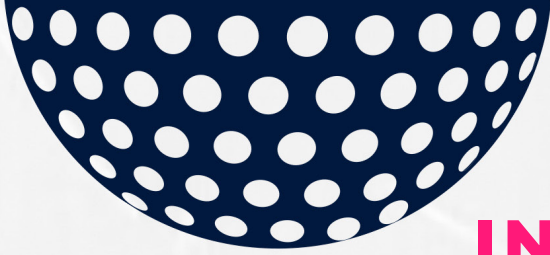

# MASTERING SELF-HELP AT HURLBURT FIELD'S AUTO HOBBY SHOP

Have you watched a Scotty Kilmer or a ChrisFix video on Youtube? If yes, you probably worked, or attempted to work, on your vehicle. If not, this 5-minute article read might be worth your while.



Something about me:

I've been a gearhead for as long as I can remember. My dad taught me how to do essential car maintenance before teaching me how to drive, which snowballed into who I am today- I love cars and am really into motorcycles. I also worked at the Auto Hobby Shop on Osan Air Base, South Korea, and enjoyed it as a hobby and work.

Located at 552 Hamby Pl, the Hurlburt Field Auto Hobby Shop is not only for motorheads and enthusiasts. Novices can take advantage of the opportunity to learn self-help auto maintenance. More than just a place to work on cars and bikes, the shop is an educational hub where individuals can acquire valuable skills, guided by knowledgeable staff, in a safe and supportive environment. The shop runs on a first-come, first-serve basis, with eight lifts and 11 stalls. Renting a bay with a hydraulic lift is only \$10 per hour or \$8 for a regular stall. Here, patrons develop the confidence and competence to tackle various automotive tasks.



Every work area has a well-organized toolbox, making locating tools accessible for the customer.

Paint booth rental is a space not typically found at an on-base Auto Hobby Shop. At the Hurlburt Field Auto Hobby Shop, patrons can complete projects and body repairs using the professional paint booth. A day rental is only \$75, and the vehicle can dry overnight in the booth without an additional charge. Paint guns are also available free of charge in the shop.

The Shop also offers comprehensive alignment services to ensure optimal

vehicle performance and safety. This service, available by appointment only, includes precise adjustments to wheel angles to promote even tire wear, improve fuel efficiency, and enhance overall driving stability.

At the Auto Hobby Shop, safety is paramount. Mr. Mike Bailey, the shop's Manager, and his team educate patrons on how to work on vehicles safely, preventing accidents and injuries. They provide constant guidance and checks to ensure everyone is safe while working on their vehicle. Closed footwear is required to utilize the shop.

The advice provided by the expert staff is at the heart of the Auto Hobby Shop experience. These professionals are skilled



mechanics and passionate teachers eager to share their knowledge. The staff offers step-by-step instructions, whether learning to change oil, replace brake pads, or conduct more complex repairs. Their support ensures patrons complete the job and understand the processes and techniques involved, building a solid foundation for future projects. To make the learning process even more accessible, the Auto Hobby Shop offers patrons the free use of ALLDATA. ALLDATA provides detailed instructions for any repair and maintenance tasks. From brake service to suspension replacement, it only needs the vehicle's year, make, and model, to list all the available repair task instructions that can be downloaded and printed. Mr. Bailey recommends that patrons research and watch tutorial videos to assess if they can complete the task. Suppose the repair

is too complex, the Auto Hobby Shop's professional service is available. Call (850) 884-6674 to check availability or make an appointment.

The beauty of self-help auto maintenance goes beyond just the financial savings; it's about building confidence and fostering a sense of accomplishment. 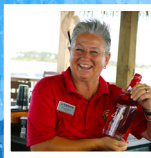

**What do the Smithsonian Institution, the National Geographic Society, cities, schools, and medical centers have in common? Libraries! Libraries are vital to various places, and this is especially true at Hurlburt Field.**

Hi, I'm Lisa Acuff, the new Librarian at the Hurlburt Field base library, and the above places represent the many contexts I have served as an information professional. I am so happy to be here!

The Hurlburt Field Library exists to support lifelong learning and quality of life. It has been said that "great libraries build communities" (R. David Lankes), and our library is no exception. In addition to our rich collection of books, test preparation materials, STEAM kits, DVDs, and video games that you can borrow for free, we also host programs that bring our community together. Our weekly storytime events, for example, allow families to unite around stories, songs, crafts, and play. We offer storytime programs for babies (ages 0-2) and children (ages 3-6).

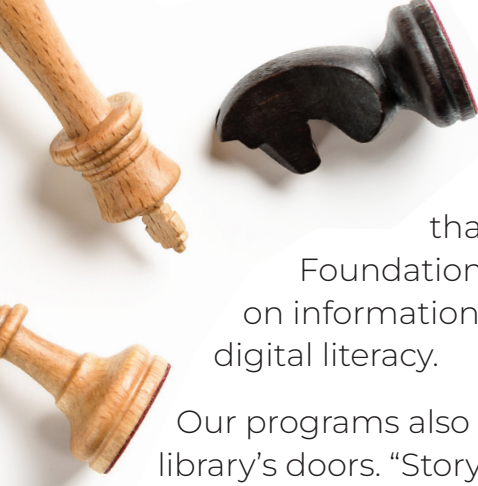
Our adult programs allow like-minded people to participate in book clubs, share cookbook recipes, and learn new skills.

For instance, we offer 3D printing workshops that teach customers how to print objects for free! Users have printed pencil holders, hibiscus flowers, bookmarks, and dinosaur bones. Our monthly cookbook club challenges participants to prepare a recipe from a cookbook and share it with others. There is an informal potluck, and recipes are passed around and shared. Featured cookbooks are available through the library's digital collection.

Our orientations and tours allow Airmen to visit the library and discover new resources for their voluntary education, professional military education, or cybersecurity training. Study guides, for example, supplement their preparation for CLEP and DSST exams, and the CSAF Leadership Library allows Airmen to explore leadership topics and achieve more in their careers.

Stay tuned for upcoming briefings that will support Airmen Foundational Competencies on information seeking and digital literacy.

Our programs also extend beyond the library's doors. "Storytime-On-The-Go" takes our programs to new locations. For example, last spring, we read books during Eggstravaganza, and in June and July, we offered stories and songs at the Mayroad Housing Community Center. Let us know if you want us to bring storytime to your location! In addition to storytime, the library enjoys participating in events across the installation, so look out for our informational tables, briefings, and resources at various places, such as the annual Education Fair, the AAPI Luau, and Freedom Fest.

Finally, our online resources provide access "Any Time, Any Place," so be sure to explore our databases that include genealogical databases (Ancestry), video storybooks (Bookflix), printable activities (Scholastic Teachables), self-paced videos from professional musicians and artists (ArtistWorks), workforce training (Interplay Learning), CLEP and DANTES/DSST study guides (Pass Your Class), automotive repair procedures (Chilton Library), online art and craft videos (Creativebug), popular plays (World Book Dramatic Learning), digital access to newspapers and magazines from more than 120 countries (Press Reader), reference materials (Credo Reference), and many more!

Since then, I have enjoyed studying all aspects of information: discovery, retrieval, literacy, information organization, knowledge management, and more. I have completed graduate degrees in both information sciences and public health, and I enjoy combining them in creative ways.

After graduating from Troy State University in 2001 with a degree in Computer Science, I began searching for a job in the IT world and was faced with many obstacles. At a job fair sponsored by the base, I learned about some job openings at the library and since I had previously worked as a Library Aid, I decided to give it a shot and was hired as a Library Technician in 2002, then became the Computer Assistant in 2005. Information is the key to success and what better place to be than the library. Having access to reliable information and resources and the desire to be of service to the military community, has been my driving force.

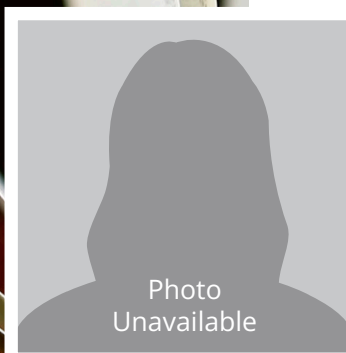


# FACES OF THE FORCE SUPPORT SQUADRON

I've always been drawn to the book world, ever since my first full-time job as a bookseller. Libraries, in turn, became a constant in my periphery, as they held all the magic of books without the pressure to sell them. It was simply never quite the right time to pursue a position. Fortunately, the other job experiences I collected in the meantime were able to help me realize just how much a library position (specifically one that works closely with children) would fulfill my career goals. I have learned so much in my nearly full year of working here, and I hope to eventually be able to pursue a Master's in Library Science so that I can continue growing and evolving my library career.

## The Defense Finance and Accounting Services (DFAS) is here to assist you with your financial and accounting activities.

### What is askDFAS?

The system allows for 24/7 online submissions and accommodates a variety of customer requests. The askDFAS system is publicly available and accessible directly by URL and through the DFAS.mil website (<https://www.dfas.mil/>). Military retirees, Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) annuitants, and survivors can complete and submit forms online, report a death, and send account questions to the DFAS Cleveland Customer Care Center via an askDFAS ticket.

### askDFAS Refresh: Making Tools Easier to Use

We continue to look for ways to make the important work of managing pay easier for military retirees, Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) annuitants, and survivors.

Using your feedback, along with ideas from partners who process your requests, we set out on a mission to make the askDFAS experience more intuitive and helpful.

One comment we heard from retirees and SBP annuitants was: finding the way to an online upload tool or online form on askDFAS wasn't always easy. This year, we undertook a major project to change that.

### The 2024 askDFAS Refresh

On May 16, 2024, we refreshed the "Ask Retired Pay" module of askDFAS to make it easier to navigate. The changes combine the familiar functionality that you've come to enjoy while also expanding your options and reorganizing tools in a thoughtful way so you can easily find the correct tool for your request.

As you survey the new options on the "Ask Retired Pay" module of askDFAS, you'll see reorganized and expanded online form upload tools, new self-service tools, the ability to report a death, and the opportunity to send account questions to the DFAS Cleveland Customer Care Center via an askDFAS ticket.

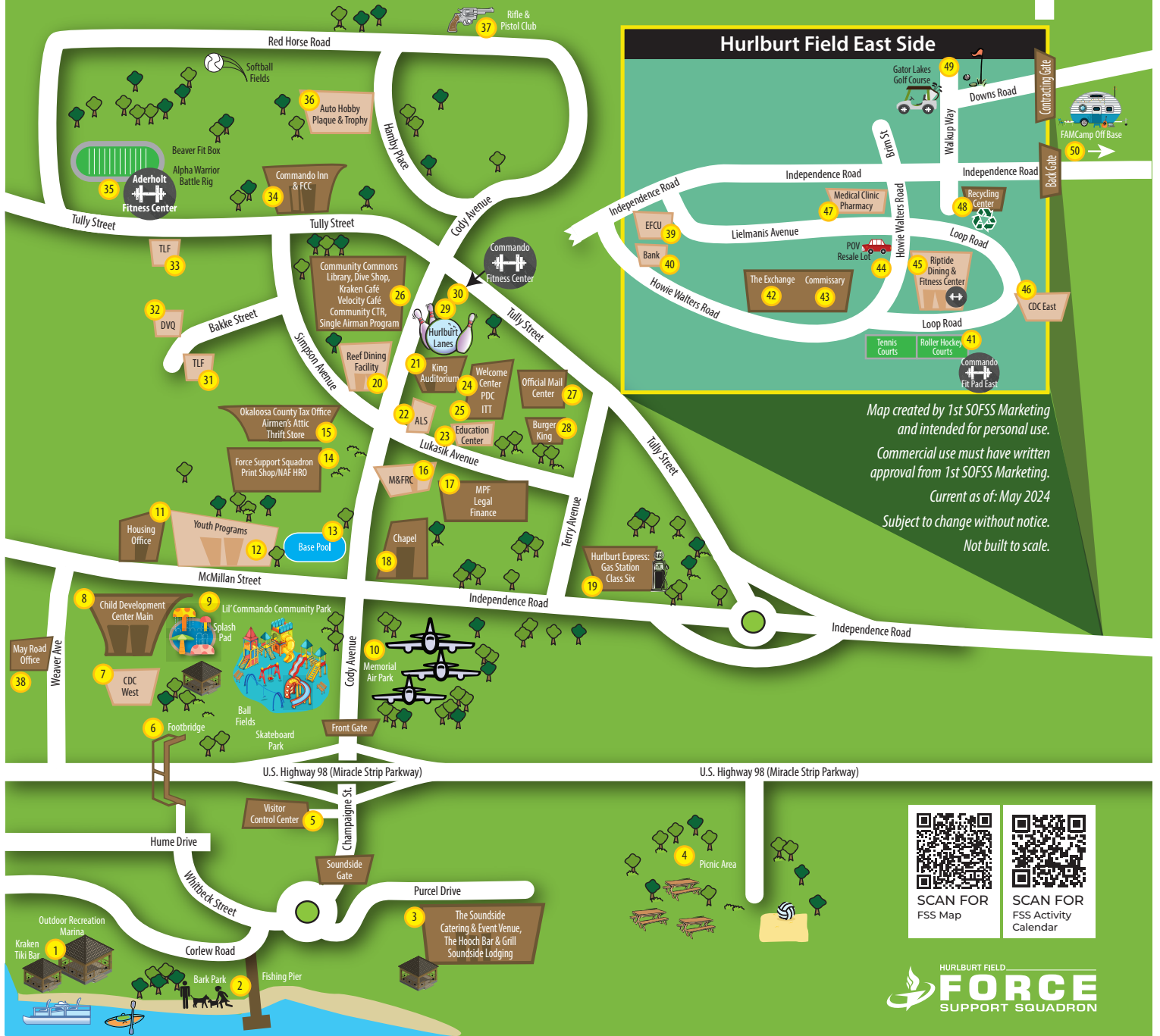
